## WILLIAM CAREY STOOD THE TEST

Williem Carey had to overcome great odds to obey the call of God. In The Challenge of Life, Oswald J. Smith noted that even the directors of the East India Company opposed Carey's work." Following is the idiotic resolution they presented to Parliament:

> "The sonding out of missionaries into one Eastem possession is the maddest, most extravagant, most costly, most indefensible project which has ever been suggested by a moonstruck fanatio."

Smith added, "In 1796, the General Assembly of the Church of Scotland passed the following infamous resolution:
"To spread the knowledge of the gospel amongst barbarians and heathens seems to be highly
preposferous."
One speaker in the House of Commons said that he would rather see a band of devils let loose in India than a band of missionaries. Such was the opposition to missions when Carey set forth. And yet, he was able to write, 'Why is my soul disquieted within me? Things may turn out better than I expect. Everything is known to God, and God cares."
William Carey stood the test, and became the father of modern missions.
