HOW BILLY SUNDAY CAME TO CHRIST

One Sunday in Chicago a group of professional ballplayers were leaving a saloon when they saw a crowd gathered on the sidewalk. A group of people were playing instruments, singing Gospel hymns and testifying of God's power to save. Harry Monroe of the Pacific Garden Mission gave a brief message. One of the men was deeply moved as boyhood memories raced through his mind. He thought of his godly mother praying for him and the old church he had attended. With tears, in his eyes he said, "Boys, I'm through! I'm going to turn from my sin and come to Christ. guess it's hard for you to understand, but we've come to a parting of the ways." Thousands were converted as he urged them to do what he had done ... come to Christ and receive His free salvation.
