Henry Wadsworth Longfellow I heard the bells on Christmas dap was filled with sornow at the tragic death of his wife in a fire in 1861. The Clivil War broke our that same year, and it seemed this was an additional punishment. Two years later, Longfellow was again saddened to hear that his own son had been seriously wounded as a lieutenant in the Army of the Potomac.

Sitting down to his desk, one Christmas day, he heard the church bells ringing and ringing. It was in this setting he wrote:

Their old famillar carols play
And wild and sweer the words repeat
Of peace on warth, good will to men.
And in despair I bowed my head: "There is no peace on earth," I said, "For hate is strong, and mocks the song
Of peace on earth, good will to men."
Then pealed the bells more loud and deep:
"God is nor dead, nor doth He sleep; The wrong shall fail, the righe prevail, With peace on earth, good will to men!"
