
Some boys, when they grew old enough to join in the hunt were named Brown Bear, Running Wolf, Black Engle, or Thunder Stone.

SAFE SIN ?

instead of repenting, they look at others who live a worst life, and that makes them feel good about themselves like the Pharisce Jesus spoke of in Luke 18 11. They feel safe

in their sins.

The problem is the Creator in His Word has declared that "all are sinners;" (Romans 3:23) that all are guilty before HIM and have need for REPENTANCE; that there is NONE righteous, no not one (Romans

The problem is God's not going to judge by society's standards, but by HIS Word.

So the wise person realizes that there is. no such thing as "Safe Sin!" That all sin in God's eyes is worthy of judgment. They also realize that the only safety from God's Judgment is found in Jesus Christ who was judged for our sins and receiving Him in our lives clears us from ALL our sins as He was judged in our place for them. They also realize that the only righteousness that God accepts is His own and that those who come to Christ are not only forgiven of all sins but have the very righteousness of God placed on them. In this way they can walk into the presence of a Holy God as they are wearing His righteousness.

Another sad truth about so called safe sin is that while all believers at the time of their salvation, saw just how awful sin is in God's sight, repented and found safe haven in Jesus Christ, allow themselves to fall back into sin at times losing fellowship. In this state many times they 50 back to thinking as the world does that their sin is not so bad. God has supplied 1 John 1:9 to get rid of that sin as soon as possible so they won't go back to the world's way of thinking; that what they are doing is really not sin. That comes as they foolishly let sin creep into their life and remain without acknowledging it as sin as God commands

It's time for ALL to wise up and remember this is God's world, He created it, He sets the rules. We are His creations and are obliged to follow His rules or be judged for not doing so. If we don't we'd better be ready to suffer the consequences. The truth is; THERE IS NO SAFE SIN!
