## NIGH UNTO DAMASCUS ABOUT NOON

I realize, of course, that not everybody knows exactly when and where they got saved, but they do know it happened and Christ is their Saviour and Lord. Whether or not you can remember the place and time like Paul, you still need to know right now that Christ is your Saviour.
