There were times, too, when Bible study was the core of public education and nearly evary literate family not only oumed a Bible but read it regularly and reverently."

A fer years later Time magazine described the spiritual origin of Amorica with these vords: "Ours is the only country founded on a good idea. That good idea combines a committment to man's inalienabpe rights with the Calvinist beliof in an ultimate moral right and sinful man's obligation to do good. These articles, embodied in the Declaration of Independence and in the Constitution, literally govern our lives today." How sad that so many today are blinded to the truth. -copied
