NAGGING NELLIE NEVER WINS



Here's what He told the Pharisees about the cup and the platter: Matthew 23:25-26- "Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye make clean the outside of the cup and of the platter, but within they are full of extortion and excess. Thou blind Pharisee, cleanse first that which is within the cup and platter, that the outside of them may be clean also."

He not only wants the inside clean, but wants the outside to: follow. God commands that we love not the world, and not pattern curselves after the world, or find pleasure in worldly things. He has called us to come out of the world and be different.

He tells us to dress modestly, and not with the attire of the harlot (Proverbs 7:10-27). We should not only dress modestly, but act modestly. We are to be modest in our speech and temperament. A sensual spirit will cause us to turn away from the God who saves and keeps us. We must walk in faith and not in the flesh.
