Many of the pastors and teachers who major on prophecy usually concentrate all their attention on the Antichrist who is coming after the rapture. However, there are only four references in the Bible where the word "antichrist or antichrists" are mentioned, and in every reference it talks about the antichrists who are present and active in the world today. Read these four references:

I John 2:18 - Little children, it is the last time; and as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many antichrists; whereby we know that it is the last time.

I John 2:22 - Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son.

I John 4:3 - And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.

II John 1:7 - For many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. This is a deceiver and antichrist.

Seriously note that these four references are the only places in the Bible where the word "antichrist" is used, and these verses tell us that "antichrists" are present in the world right now!

Don't lose sleep and waste time over the Antichrist who is coming after the Rapture. The real and genuine danger is that we are surrounded by antichrists right now, functioning by the spirit of antichrist (I John 4:3). The Apostle Paul issues the same caution in II Thessalonians 2:7, "For the mystery of iniquity doth already work..." As contemporary Christianity takes over the religious realm, we see that the world is coming into the churches in a big way. Over 200 perversions of the Bible are now in print and being used in the place of the King James Bible. Worldly Rock music with the beat, the jump and the jive is taking the place of Godly hymns and songs. Immodesty in dress is everywhere. Homosexual lifestyle is embraced and practiced by church members. The antichrists are present and active right now and the consequences are evident everywhere. The result is that false religion is sending multitudes to hell. Churches are not restraining the antichrists; they are welcoming them.
