MY HUSBAND

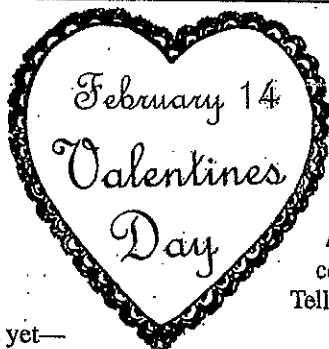
He is that special someone
