Apart from the Word of God we cannot know or have any hope whatever. You can never get to Heaven because you go to church, have been baptized or are active in church work, etc. You are saved by putting your trust and faith in the Lord Jesus Christ who died for your sins and rose again from the dead. Here are a few verses we need to read and understand:

Ephesian 2:8-9 - For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the GIFT of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.

John 1:12 - But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name.

John 3:16 - For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him, should not perish, but have everlasting life.

I John 5:12-13 - He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life. These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may KNOW that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.
