FUNDAMENTALISM OR FANATICISM?

GRACE BAPTIST CHURCH is a fundamental, independent Baptist Church. Fundamentalism, according to Webster's dictionary, is this: "A belief that the Bible is to be accepted literally as an infallible document." What that means is that Grace Baptist Church folks believe that the Bible is the complete, revealed, perfect Word of God, and as such we teach, preach and practice it to the best of our knowledge.

What the media often mistakenly classifies as fundamentalism is really fanaticism; there is a vast difference between the two. Just remember, a fundamental Christian is one who believes the Bible is God's Word and it is his final authority in faith and practice. This is the same principle that coaches and business leaders use. If they want to have a winning team or successful business, they stick with the fundamentals of the game or the fundamentals of good business practices. So with the Christian, to be useful and successful in our Christian lives, to be a blessing and a help to others, we stick with the fundamentals of our faith.

The following are some wonderful truths about fundamentalism that I have gleaned from several sources. I believe it will be profitable and enlightening to those who desire to know the truth.

- 1. A fundamentalist is one who embraces, tenaciously holds to and practices the truth as found in God's Word.
- 2. A fundamentalist has zeal, but his zeal is disciplined and tempered by the truth of God's Word.
- 3. A fundamentalist obeys the government and the laws of the land, and submits to authority unless that authority seeks to usurp the authority of God.
- 4. A fundamentalist will not bomb airports, hijack airliners, take people hostage or commit terrorist acts of any kind.
- 5. A fundamentalist does not seek to take human life.
- 6. A fundamentalist will not build a religious commune and engage in sexual orgies.
- 7. A fundamentalist is opposed to abortion (which we believe is premeditated murder of innocent unborn human beings), opposed to homosexuality, promiscuity, pornography, drugs, booze, immorality, tyranny, communism, etc.
- 8. A fundamentalist believes in and is a promoter of strong, godly, family life and values.
- 9. A fundamentalist is not intolerant. He believes that every person must have the right to believe what he chooses and practice what he believes, as long as it does not threaten man's well-being; but he also insists that God has only one way to Heaven and that is through the blood of Christ.
- 10. A fundamentalist loves God and other people; he loves the church; he desires and seeks the salvation of the lost.
- 11. A fundamentalist loves his country and his flag, and is ready to defend it against any and everyone who seeks to take away liberty; he is ready to oppose wrong and defend truth.

Now then, listen to the dictionary's definition of fanaticism: "One who is possessed of wild and extravagant opinions. He has an inordinate zeal that may be influenced by religion, revolution, political ambition, social activism, racial bigotry and other causes. He may be often ruled by bigotry and prejudice and be given to wild imaginations and emotionalism, rather than being disciplined by sound judgment based on truth."

It is very easy to see the difference between fundamentalism and fanaticism. Don't be fooled by the liberal media.

I have never failed to hit the "bulls eye" when I aimed at "nothing."


