-An atom is so small that one tiny grain of salt contains one trillion atoms.



Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us... That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.




JESUS WANTS YOU TO BE SAVED TODAY
